AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUSINESS NAMES (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE; AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES.

ENACTED by the Governor of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Business Names (Registration) (Amendment) Ordinance 2011 and shall come into operation on 29 July 2011.

Interpretation

2. In this Ordinance “principal Ordinance” means the Business Names (Registration) Ordinance.

Section 7 amended

3. Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is amended by deleting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection—

“(2) Every registration, and every renewal of registration, shall be effected, and shall remain valid, for a period of one year from the date of the certificate of registration, and shall thereafter in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, be renewed from time to time for successive periods, each of one year duration, for so long as the firm or individual is required to be registered under the provisions of this Ordinance.”.

Section 8 amended

4. Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is amended by renumbering the section s subsection (1) and by inserting the following after subsection (1)—

“(2) The prescribed non- refundable fee shall be paid to the Registrar in respect of any application to change the registered business name.”.
