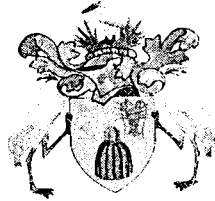

PROCEEDS OF CRIME (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 16 of 2009)

Ord. 12 of 2007

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PROCEEDS OF CRIME ORDINANCE AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES.

ENACTED by the Acting Governor of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime (Amendment) Ordinance 2009 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 8th day of October 2007.

Amendment of section 143

2. Section 143 (c) (1) of the Proceeds of Crime Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinance") is amended by inserting after the word "section" the words "117,118 or 119".

Amendment to Schedule 5

3. Schedule 5 to the principal Ordinance is amended-

- (a) in paragraph 3, by deleting the word "to" where it first occurs and substituting "97 to 107";
(b) in paragraph 4 (1), by deleting the word "and" where it first occurs and substituting " 117, 118 and 119"; and
(c) in paragraph 4 (2), by inserting after the word "section" the word "120".

Amendment to Schedule 6

4. Schedule 6 to the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after item 1 the following items:

Table with 4 columns: No., Enactment, Extent of amendment or repeal, Date that amendment or repeal is effective. It lists items 2 and 3 from Schedule 6, both referring to the whole Ordinance being repealed.
