### TCI FSC Unveils “The Shield” as Its New Emblem and Visual Identity

The Turks and Caicos Islands Financial Services Commission (the Commission) has unveiled The Shield, its new emblem and visual identity, in a video explainer highlighting the meaning and inspiration behind the refreshed design.

The launch marks an important milestone in the Commission’s institutional development. The new identity reflects the FSC’s evolution as a modern, accessible and internationally aligned regulator, while remaining grounded in the heritage and character of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Established in 2001, the Commission has continued to evolve alongside the financial services sector. It remains committed to its mandate to regulate and supervise the industry, promote stability and integrity, and strengthen the resilience of the financial services sector.

Presented in navy and gold, The Shield symbolises stewardship, vigilance and direction. Each element reflects the FSC’s values and the heritage of the Turks and Caicos Islands:

- **The Lighthouse** represents leadership and guidance;
- **The Wave** reflects the Territory’s maritime heritage and global connections;
- **The Flamingo** represents local identity and accessibility; and
- **“EST. 2001”** recognises the Commission’s history and experience.

The transition to the new visual identity will begin on 1 September 2026, with The Shield scheduled to be fully implemented across the FSC’s digital platforms, official documents, stakeholder communications and other public-facing materials from 1 October 2026.

While the Commission’s visual identity is changing, its core mission remains unchanged. The Commission will continue to safeguard confidence in the financial services sector, promote sound regulatory practices and support the sustainable development of the industry for the benefit of the Turks and Caicos Islands.
