## **Syria**

- The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that three hundred and forty-eight (348) entries have been amended in the <u>Syria Sanctions</u> <u>Regime</u><sup>1</sup> and are still subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
