Cyber

- 1. The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that nineteen (19) entries have been added to the <u>Cyber Financial Sanctions Regime¹</u> and are now subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. Two (2) entries have been amended and are still subject to an asset freeze.
- 3. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
